Policy Responsibilities	 The Deanship of Students Affairs is responsible for: Coordinating and overseeing the implementation of this policy. Providing support and resources to facilitate effective community engagement. Academic and Administrative Departments are responsible for: Implementing this policy within their respective areas and in alignment with the university's strategic goals for community engagement. Faculty, Staff, and Students are responsible for: Conducting themselves in a manner that reflects the university's commitment to ethical and respectful community engagement.
