Sustainability – vs – Business Continuity

Sustainability ≠ Business continuity

- **Sustainability** is a long-term concept that focuses on ensuring the long-term survival of an organization.
- **Business continuity** is a concept with a short-term focus, that aims to guarantee an organization's operational capability during emergencies.
- Sustainability and business continuity are intricately linked. Organizations dedicated to sustainability demonstrate greater resilience to external changes, enabling them to maintain operations even during emergencies.

Jordan's commitment towards achieving the sustainable development goals

His Majesty King Abdullah II signed Jordan's commitment to achieving the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals during the United Nations General Assembly meeting in New York on September 25, 2015.

1. Eliminate **poverty and hunger**.

5. Protecting the **environment** and combating **climate change**.
6. Promoting **peace**, justice, and strong **institutions**.
7. Establishing global **partnerships** to achieve sustainable development.

The added value of implementing sustainability standards

1. **Improving environmental performance:**

Reduce resource and energy consumption, reduce pollution and waste, and improve process efficiency.

2. **Fostering innovation:**

Developing sustainable services, discovering new business opportunities, and improving competitiveness.

3. **Improving the university's reputation:**

Attracting students and partners, enhancing stakeholder confidence, and improving the university's image in society.

4. **Reducing risks:**

Extreme poverty is a situation in which a person or family lives on less than US\$1.90 (1.33 Jordanian dinars) per day. People living in extreme poverty suffer from lack of food, shelter, health care, education, and inequality.

Hunger is a state of insufficient food intake or inadequate nutrition, leading to malnutrition and diseases. 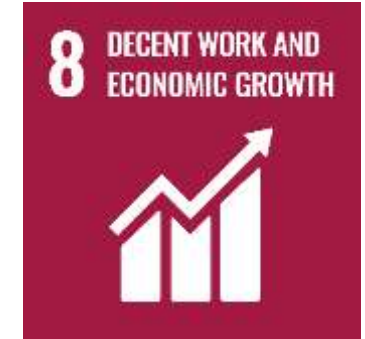

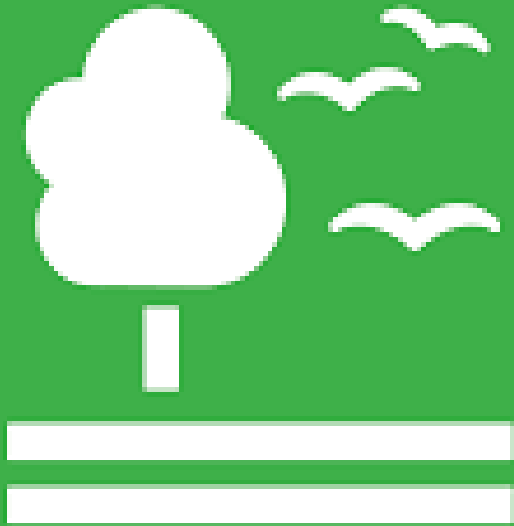

The role of Al-Ahliyya Amman University in achieving sustainable development goals

1. Strengthening **cooperation between universities and the private sector** by providing practical and applied training opportunities for students to develop their practical skills and learn about the work environment, in addition to better understanding the needs of the labor market and ensuring that education is consistent with the required skills, which contributes to achieving sustainable development by improving the quality of education and increasing employment opportunities. Work for graduates.
2. Spreading the **culture of sustainability**, and enhancing awareness and social responsibility towards sustainability by organizing awareness campaigns and comprehensive educational events for students and the local community, including topics such as climate change, gender equality, the importance of clean water, preserving biodiversity, and sustainable urban planning, in a way that enhances community participation and contributes In achieving sustainable development.
3. Promoting **equity and diversity in education** by adopting comprehensive and non-discriminatory admission policies, including providing scholarships to students from low-income families in Jordan and poor countries, and ensuring free access to educational resources for all individuals, including ethnic minorities, low-income students, Non-traditional students, women, students with disabilities, and recent refugees, with the aim of providing equal educational opportunities for all and encouraging broad and diverse participation.

4. Promote **equity and diversity in the work environment** by recruiting workers from the local community and taking planned actions to ensure broad representation of students, staff, and faculty from underrepresented groups, which encourages equal employment opportunities and promotes diversity and equity in the student and worker community.
5. Promoting **entrepreneurship and innovation** by supporting students and researchers in developing their competitive capabilities in the labor market, encouraging women's participation in technology and science, supporting innovation in the fields of renewable energy and environmental technology, providing financial resources to start small businesses and innovative projects, and encouraging the development of sustainable solutions and social projects to improve local communities. And combating climate change.
6. **Strengthening cooperation and building partnerships with relevant partners** including governments, industry, universities, local communities, and non-governmental organizations to support innovation and entrepreneurship, and achieve sustainable development goals such as eradicating poverty and hunger, promoting health and well-being, and combating climate change, in addition to developing sustainable solutions. To global challenges such as water management and the preservation of underwater life, and to encourage cultural and academic exchange at the international level.
7. Adopting **effective strategies for managing and saving water** on campus by installing drinking water fountains, encouraging student participation in projects related to water and sanitation, measuring the total volume of water used and preventing contaminated water from entering the system, implementing building standards to reduce water consumption, and planting the campus with plants that are tolerant. Drought to reduce water use.

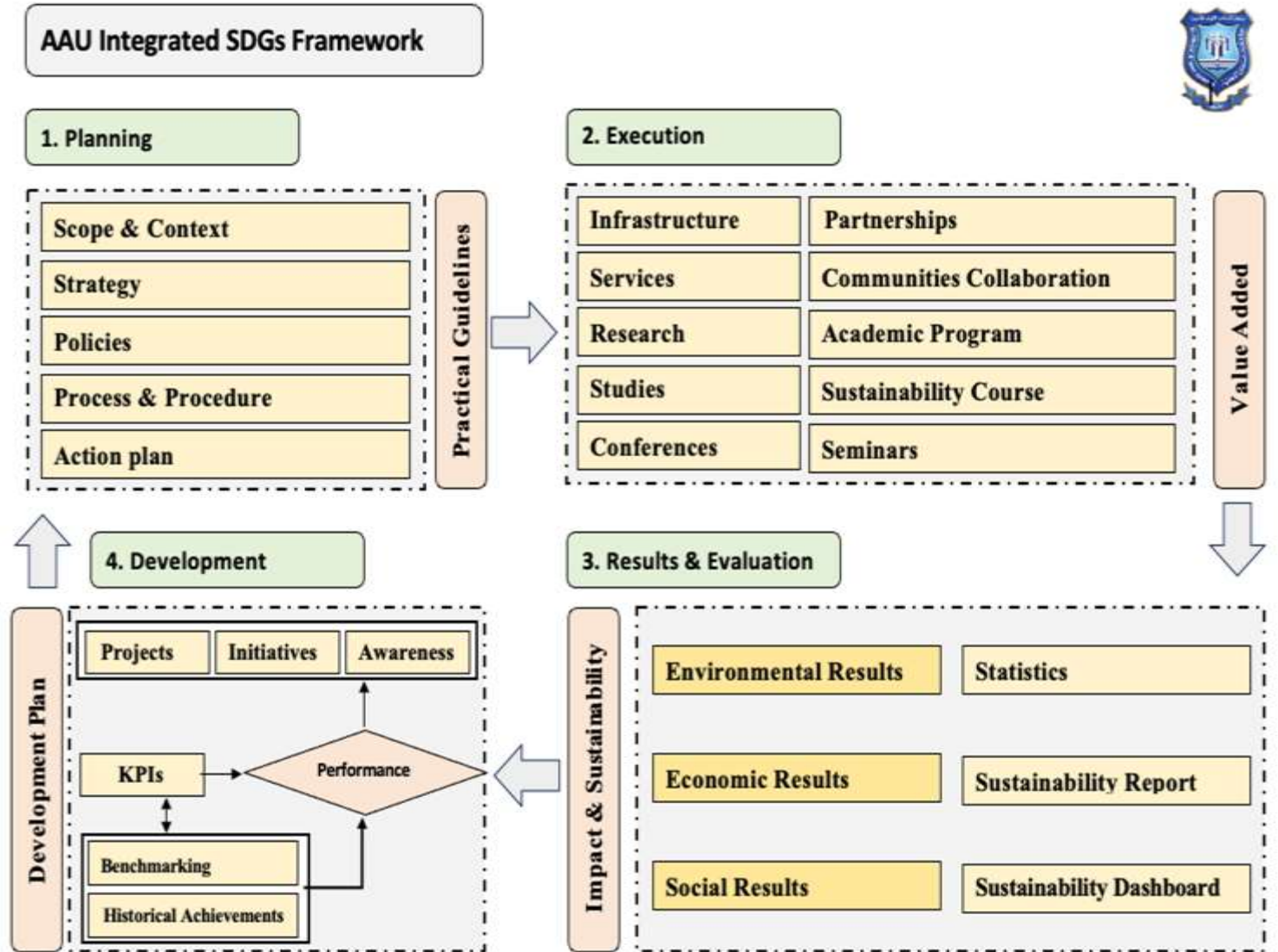
8. **Encourage and support the preparation and dissemination of research** in multiple areas related to sustainability standards, including the challenges of poverty, hunger, health, gender equality, water technology, energy, environment, and urban management.
9. **Active participation** in international, regional, and national **conferences and seminars** specialized in sustainability standards.
10. **Providing specialized educational curricula and programs that embrace the concept of sustainability**, including enhancing awareness and skills in areas such as sustainable agriculture, marine biology, health and well-being, water and energy management, environmental sciences, climate change, and law and human rights. These programs include conducting workshops, mentorship programs, and providing access to university facilities.
11. **Contribute to the development and implementation of comprehensive policies and guidelines that support industry**, infrastructure improvement, economic justice, and peace. These efforts include adopting anti-discrimination and anti-harassment policies, providing reasonable accommodation strategies for persons with disabilities, as well as strengthening water and sanitation management.
12. **Providing comprehensive programs to serve the university community and the local community**, including providing food, housing, transportation, and legal services for students from low-income families, in addition to programs to promote public health.
13. Establish a committee, **office** or employee charged with providing advice and implementing policies, programs and training courses related to **diversity and human rights**, while providing accessible facilities and support services for persons with disabilities, including personal assistants, interpreters and appropriate accessibility plans.

14. Adopting and applying **sustainable strategies in campus management**, including advanced waste management, use of renewable energy, and enhancing student participation in activities and decisions affecting sustainability. Encouraging interaction with the local community to develop sustainable projects and supporting social and economic innovation by students and faculty to promote responsible consumption and production, in addition to integrating renewable energy and energy efficiency concepts and solutions into research and curricula.
15. Develop advanced techniques to monitor and protect marine life, spread awareness about the importance of marine biodiversity and the need to preserve it, and encourage students to **participate in volunteer projects and activities to preserve the marine environment**, including beach cleanups and species monitoring programs.
16. Adopting and encouraging the **application of sustainable administrative practices in all aspects of university life**, including developing and managing the campus in accordance with the principles of sustainable development.
17. Encouraging students to **think critically about justice and peace issues**, providing training to develop justice and peace enhancing skills, promoting interaction between students from diverse backgrounds to mutually understand justice and peace issues, and adopting sustainable management practices while participating in social responsibility initiatives.
