TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All disciplines are concerned with a preference for the following fields:
 - Sciences: environmental sciences and climate change, agriculture, digital sciences, biology, chemistry, physics, energy, health, earth sciences, etc.
 - Engineering
 - IT (priority to coding and data sciences)
 - Business and administration
 - Tourism and hospitality
 - law
 - Languages
 - Social and human sciences

• Eligible Candidates

- Jordanian citizens
- No more than 30 for Master and 36 years old for PhD
- Holder of a bachelor degree with minimum academic level "good"
- Language proficiency:
 - ✓ Candidates who apply for a French program: minimum DELF B2
 - ✓ Candidates who apply for an English program : IELTS, TOEFL or TOEIC (depending on Master and PhD requirements)

• The scholarship includes :

- A monthly allowance for the duration of the degree from September 1st 2023 (for information the allowance in 2022 was 1500 euros/month for Phd; and 700 euros/month for Master);
- Social security coverage for the duration of the scholarship;
- One round-trip ticket, between France and Jordan, economy class, with transfer to the city of studies;
- Priority access for an accommodation in university student residence;
- National tuition fees in universities recognized by the French Ministry of Higher education. Any additional tuition fees will be covered by the student.

HOW TO APPLY?

Step 1

- Send your application, only by email, to the following address: bourses-scac.amman-amba@diplomatie.gouv.fr
- The email subject must be "French Embassy scholarship 2023 application"

THE APPLICATION MUST CONTAIN:

- A copy of the passport
- A curriculum vitae (CV)
- A copy of all degrees, from the Tawjihi or equivalent certificate, with transcripts
- Certificates of language level
- A motivation letter. This motivation letter should contain a description of :
 - \circ your motivation and interests regarding the academic programs you wish to follow in France (Master or PhD);
 - o the reasons why you choose France for your studies ;
 - o what is your professional project after your studies in France.
- For Master level: the candidate must apply to the Masters he/she wants to do in France through the Etudes en France website (https://pastel.diplomatie.gouv.fr/etudesenfrance/) and mention the Etudes en France file number in the email sent to bourses-scac.amman-amba@diplomatie.gouv.fr . In the case of a Master that is not in the Etudes en France website, the candidate must send a list of 3 masters identified or an admission letter. For help on the Etudes en France process, please contact: amman@campusfrance.org
- For PhD level: an admission letter from a supervisor and/or contact proofs with the PhD School chosen by the candidate.

The documents of the application file must be in French or English (any document in Arabic must be translated)

Step 2

Pre-selection of the application files will be done by the Scholarship Commission of the Cultural Section of the French Embassy in Jordan on the base of:

- Academic excellence and motivation of the candidate;
- Project relevance and consistency.

Step 3

The pre-selected candidates will be interviewed by the jury of the Scholarship Commission, and the following aspects will be assessed by the jury during the interview:

- Presentation and relevance of the study project;
- Knowledge of the subject;
- Professional project of the candidate;
- Language proficiency in French or English based on the chosen degree.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 15th of January 2023

INTERVIEW: 24th of January to 7th of February 2023

RESULTS: 22nd of FEBRUARY 2023
