Purpose	The purpose of this policy is to affirm AAU's commitment to contributing to the eradication of poverty and to promoting economic and social well-being for all members of the university community and beyond. This policy outlines the university's approach to understanding, addressing, and advocating for solutions to poverty, aligning with global efforts	
	to ensure no one is left behind.	
Scope	This policy applies to all university operations, activities, partnerships, and academic endeavors that have the potential to impact economic and social inclusion, both within the university community and in the broader society.	
Responsibilities	 The specialized committee approved by the university presidency is responsible for: Coordinating the implementation of this policy. Providing guidance and resources to facilitate poverty alleviation initiatives. Academic and Administrative Departments are responsible for: Integrating the principles of this policy into their operations, research, teaching, and community engagement activities. All University Members are responsible for: Contributing to the university's efforts to end poverty through their roles, research, teaching, and engagement in community service. 	
Compliance	Non-compliance with this policy may be addressed through review and feedback processes. Continuous non-compliance may lead to corrective actions as deemed necessary by the university administration.	
Review	The policy will be reviewed and updated annually, or as needed, to reflect the evolving understanding of poverty and align with the university's strategic goals and values.
