This policy aims to decrease the use of single-use plastics, improve plastic waste management, and encourage alternatives that are more sustainable.	
Policy Scope	This policy applies to all university operations, activities, departments, and members, including students, faculty, staff, contractors, and visitors. It encompasses the procurement, use, disposal, and recycling of plastic materials within the university.
