Policy Scope	This policy applies to all aspects of the university's operations, including but not limited to campus development and maintenance, procurement, waste management, energy use, water conservation, transportation, and food services. It also encompasses the university's academic and research activities as well as its community and public engagement initiatives.	
Policy Responsibilities	 1. The Sustainability Office is responsible for: Coordinating and overseeing the implementation of this policy. Providing guidance and support to departments and units on integrating sustainability into their operations and activities. 	



	 2. All university departments and units are responsible for: Integrating sustainability principles into their operations, activities, and decision-making processes. Collaborating with the Sustainability Office and other departments to achieve the university's sustainability goals. 3. All members of the university community are responsible for: Contributing to the achievement of the university's sustainability goals through their actions and choices. Participating in sustainability initiatives and programs. 	
Policy Compliance	Non-compliance with this policy may be addressed through review and feedback mechanisms. The university is committed to fostering a supportive and collaborative environment for the implementation of sustainability practices.	
Policy Review	This policy will be reviewed and, if necessary, revised every year or as needed to ensure it remains relevant, reflects the latest sustainability standards and practices, and aligns with the university's goals and objectives.
